EIkRM V2 (RMS) Remote Management Software is a free downloadable upgrade for existing owners of EIkRM. Please do not delete or uninstall the previous version as the Product License Key required by the previous version needs to be present for use by the new version. This key allows the new EIkRM to operate in “non-demo” mode. It is a good idea to keep a copy of the Product License Key in a safe secure location in case it is ever needed.

OWNERS OF ELKTS07 TOUCHSCREENS: The new EIkRM V2 (RMS) software will not operate from the TS07 main memory. It must be installed and executed from a Compact Flash (CF) memory card, purchased and installed into the CF socket on the inside back of the TS07 circuit board. There are two ways to accomplish this.

1) Purchase a CF card at a local computer store, then download the free EIkRMS upgrade software and copy it onto the CF card in a directly named “EIkRM”. 2) Purchase a CF card preloaded with the EIkRMS Upgrade from ELK.

When upgrading an existing copy of EIkRM on a personal computer the new version will automatically look for the Product License Key and then operate in full (non-demo) mode as long as the key exists.

Jun 8, 2009 - ElkRM (RMS) Remote Management Software - Ver 2.0.2

ElkRM (RMS) has a new look and added functionality from the original ElkRM. The part number is still ElkRM while the RMS reference denotes the official name which is: 'Remote Management Software.'

1. The # key on the Security page can now be used to bypass zones, the same way a traditional keypad # key works. Zone bypassing also may be done from the Security / Status page.
 2. Found and fixed an indexing issue with the Keypad select combo box under Installer setup.
 3. 6 digit User Codes were not working properly - This is now fixed.
 4. Increased response time on the Climate page to resolve a reported issue of climate status not always displaying correctly when first accessing the Climate page.
 5. Increased response time on Sensors Page. Similar situation to the Climate page report above.
 6. Found and fixed an issue with Backlight dimming on Touchscreens at certain time variables - This has been fixed and the maximum time-out value is now 3 minutes.
 7. Screensaver feature - Found and fixed an issue which caused the screen to go black if a "Photos" folder contained no pictures or image.
 8. Found and fixed an indexing/lookup problem which could cause a false Fire Trouble Indication.
 9. Modified the command sent by On/Off buttons on the lighting page. Instead of sending a pc followed by a dim value ElkRM now sends a pn for ON, and a pf for OFF. This helps maintain compatible with legacy X10 devices.
 10. Found and fixed an indexing problem related to multiple Russound Controllers.
 11. Fan mode graphics were inversed on the Climate page - Resolved.
 12. Event Log - Increased the number of event types that can now be displayed when receiving the event log.
 13. Serial Baud rate select box under Installer Setup was not populating correctly - Resolved.
 14. Found and fixed an issue with updating meta data when first accessing the Audio page.
 15. Video "Scan" button was not always displaying on the Video page - Resolved.
 16. Added to the zone types that may now be shown on the Security / Status page.
 17. Modified the way a page slider button operates. Clicking now advances 1 page at a time (forward or back).
 18. Added Weather page feature which retrieves weather data from Yahoo.com for a specified zip code.
 19. UPDATING - Due to security issues with Vista Operating Systems the UPDATE button is now only displayed when ElkRM is running on a Touchscreen. When operating on a PC it is now necessary to manually download and install any Update to ElkRM from the Elk Products Website.
 20. Another change required due Vista Operating Systems - On PCs All setting and configuration files are now stored in the Applications Data folder.
 21. The ability to select music by Song/Artist/Genre has been reinstated on the Russound Audio SMS3/iPod pages.
 22. Stay Mode Arming "silent" exit countdown tone - Effective with this ElkRM version, and provided the connected M1 has firmware version x.x.20 or LATER, the Stay mode countdown will now be quiet. I.E. It will no longer produce audible indication when armed Stay, which is the way a traditional Keypad operates. NOTE: M1 Firmware MUST BE version x.x.20 or later.
 23. Increased slightly the image display size on the Video page.
 24. Added ability to Save the downloaded Event Log. NOTE: This is only available in ElkRM when operating on a PC.

Dec 30, 2008 - ElkRM V2 (RMS) Remote Management Software - Ver 2.0.0

1. ElkRM Version 2 (RMS) introduces a new look and feel to the original ElkRM. Please note that the official ordering part number continues to be ElkRM. The reference to RMS refers to the official name which has always been 'Remote Management Software.
 2. The new version provides a home screen with icons buttons to select individual sub pages. Sub pages now run in full screen mode with an icon button to return back to the home page.
 3. The original ElkRM Setup program is still used to set up cameras, web links, audio, etc. However, a new setup program called "designer" is slated to be introduced in early 2009 which will allow near complete customization of the graphics and operation.

Nov 29, 2006 - ElkRM New application software Ver 1.2.10

1. Added VIDEO to the feature list.
2. Added "Are you sure you want to" message boxes when the user clicks on "Synchronize" or the "Update" button.
3. Fixed bug in "Climate" when temperature was in Celsius mode and the setpoints were less than 10 deg. Celsius.
4. Fixed bug in the socket connections. Sockets were not always getting fully shutdown which would eat up memory and potentially get the M1XEP to quit responding to incoming socket connections. (Filling up it's maximum number of sockets)

NOTES:

- RM_Setup.exe added to the install package. This program is used (for now) just to setup cameras in ElkRM.
- This program is intended to run on a PC and will require the .NET Framework version 2.0 to run.
- This program creates a file "Default.xml" when it launches. This file holds the camera setup.
- The setup utility is an option in the install package so the installer can choose if he/she wants to install it on current machine.
- When updating from a previous version to version 1.2.10 it is necessary to run the update twice. During the second update, when asked if the skins should be updated, choose YES. This will ensure that ElkRM has the most up-to-date skins files.

July 19, 2006 - ElkRM New application software Ver 1.2.8

1. Added new lighting sliders to make the lighting page more user-friendly.
2. Also added on/off buttons to the lighting page instead of the "toggle" style button.

Apr 18, 2006 - ElkRM New application software Ver. 1.2.6

1. Resolved issue with lighting status not always displaying correctly. Lighting banks above 0 in the ASCII protocol were not being indexed correctly.
2. Resolved issue of screens becoming scrambled with running on a PDA. Some PDA screens run a higher DPI (dots per inch) resolution, causing fonts to be too large on the screen and thus covering up other controls.
3. Added functionality for keypad beeps and chime. The default sounds are stored as .wav files in the ElkRM file folder. "Beep.wav" and "Chime.wav" To substitute your own favorite .wav sound first backup or rename the original file. EG: "Beep.org" Then substitute your own .wav sound file by renaming it to "Beep.wav" and placing it into the ElkRM folder.
4. Added new controls for adjusting the backlight and sound volume for when ElkRM is running on the touchscreen.
5. Removed the tab selection control for the setting pages. This caused erroneous results when run on a Pocket PC.
